**ACTION ITEMS**

**Consideration of Adoption of Resolution Number 1243 Approving the 2012 General Plan and Submitting it to the Voters for Ratification at the March 13, 2012 Election**

Senior Planner Molly Hood stated that the General Plan is the primary tool for guiding the future of the town in its efforts to enhance a livable and sustainable built environment that is sensitive to issues which impact the people who live, learn, work and play in Paradise Valley. On a daily basis the town is faced with tough choices about resort development and operation, SUP applications and development, housing, transportation, neighborhood improvement, and service delivery. The General Plan provides a guide for making these choices by describing long-term goals for the town's future as well as policies to guide day-to-day land use and resource allocation decisions.

She stated that the Town held a total of 58 public meetings to date including four Council work sessions and two Council public hearings.

**Motion and vote:** Councilmember Collins moved to adopt Resolution Number 1243, adopting the 2012 General Plan dated November 4, 2011, with the following change to Policy M 4.4.1.2:

*Private Roadway Gates: The Town shall discourage the installation of private roadway gates, but shall not require public access onto those created ~~private~~ **public** roadways*


and submitting the Plan to the voters at the March 13, 2012 Regular Election for ratification.

Vice Mayor Hamway seconded the motion which passed by a vote of 7 - 0.
