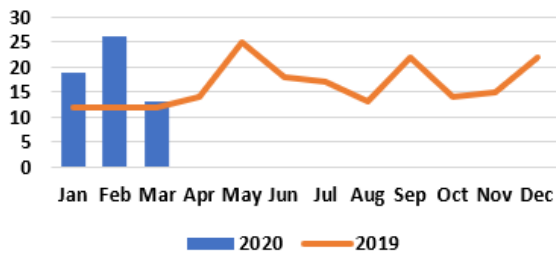

- Part 1 Crimes include: Crimes against Persons & Property crimes

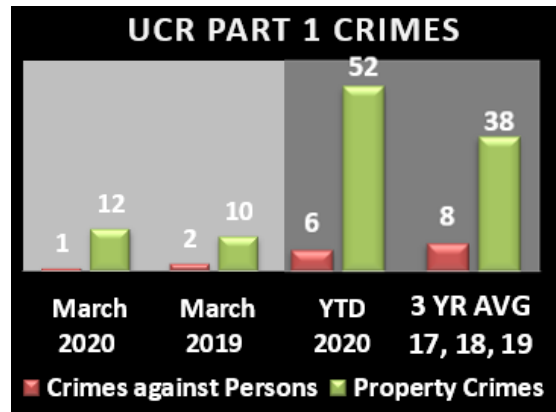
- Crimes against Persons includes: homicide, sexual assault, robbery, aggravated assault and simple assault.

UCR 2020 vs 2019



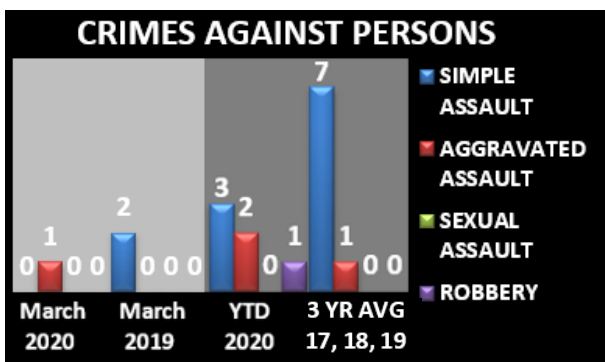
- In March, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported **13** Part 1 Crimes to the FBI.

CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

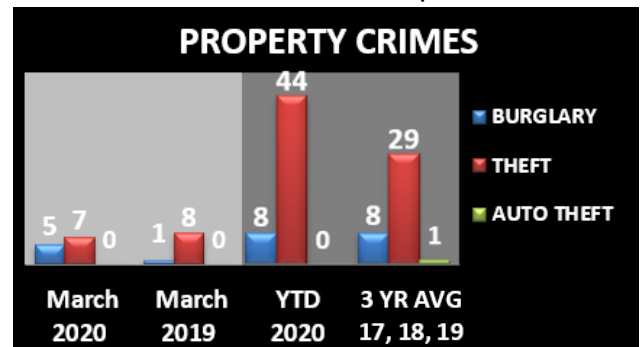
In March, there was **1** aggravated assault. There were no homicides, robberies, simple assaults or sexual assaults.



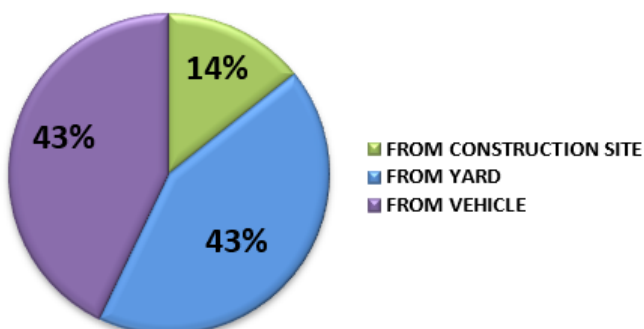
PROPERTY CRIMES

Thefts decreased **13%**

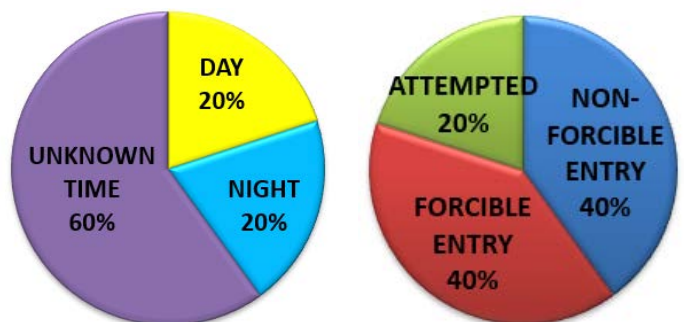
In March, property crimes consisted of **7** thefts and **5** burglaries. There were no arsons or auto thefts reported.

Emergency Calls decreased

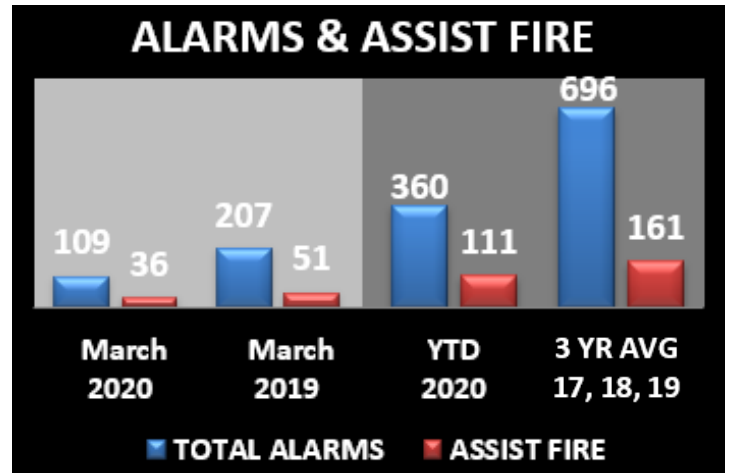
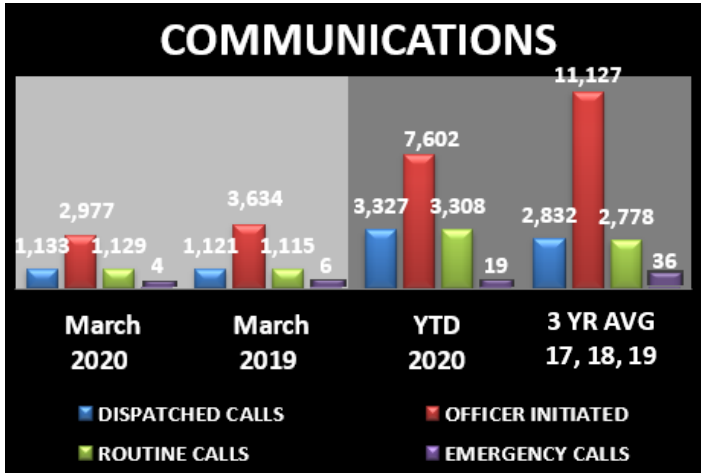

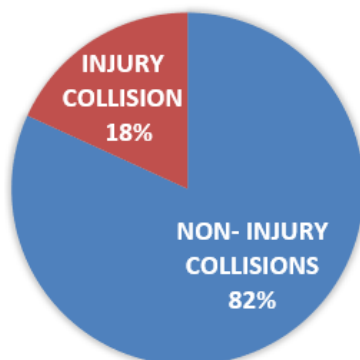
Non-Injury collisions decreased

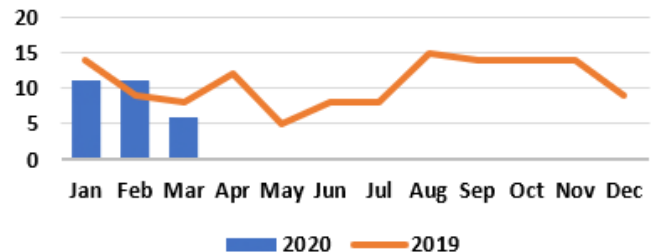
In March, there were **9** non-injury collisions and **2** injury collisions.
