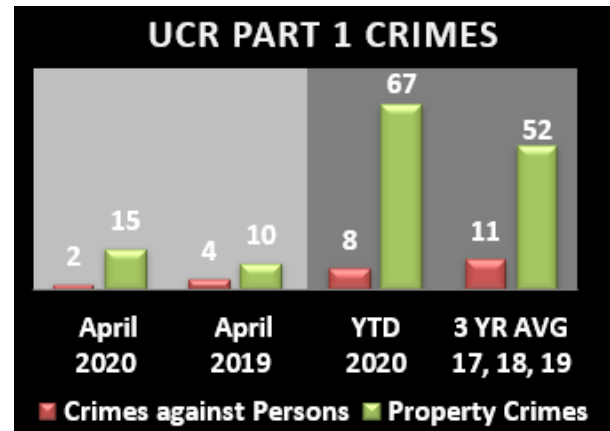
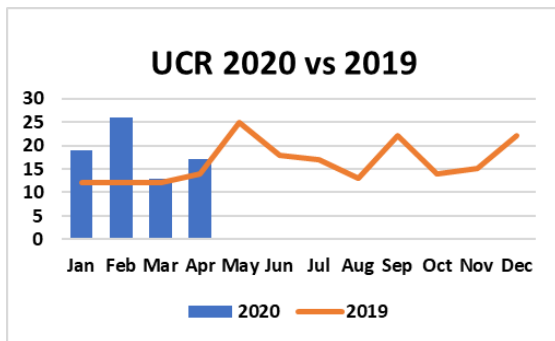


- Part 1 Crimes include: Crimes against Persons & Property crimes

- Property crimes includes: burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft and arson.

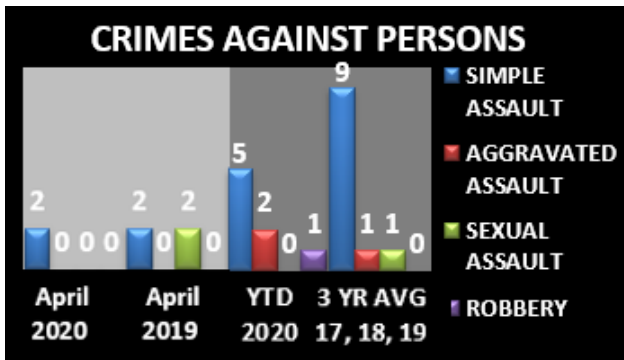
- In April, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported **17** Part 1 Crimes to the FBI.

### CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

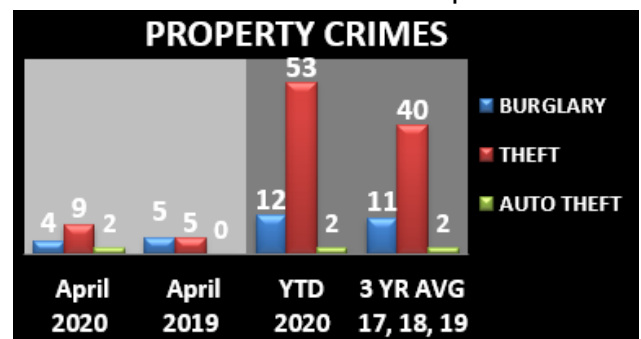
In April, there were **2** simple assaults. There were no homicides, robberies, aggravated assaults or sexual assaults.



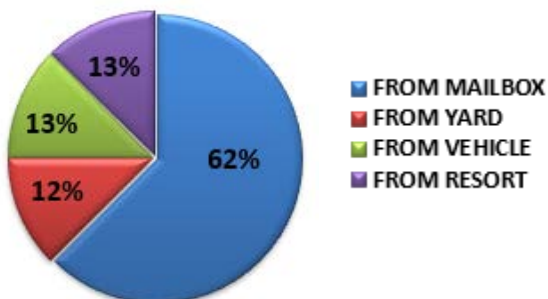
### PROPERTY CRIMES

Burglaries decreased **20%**

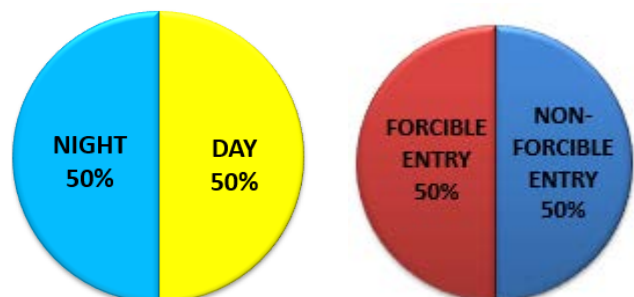
In April, property crimes consisted of **9** thefts, **4** burglaries and **2** auto thefts. There were no arsons reported.

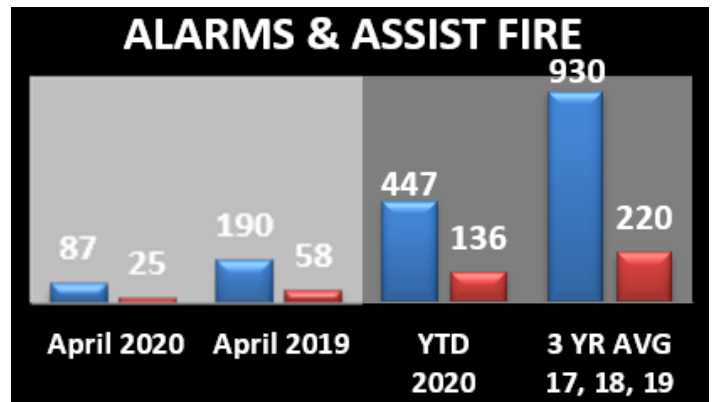
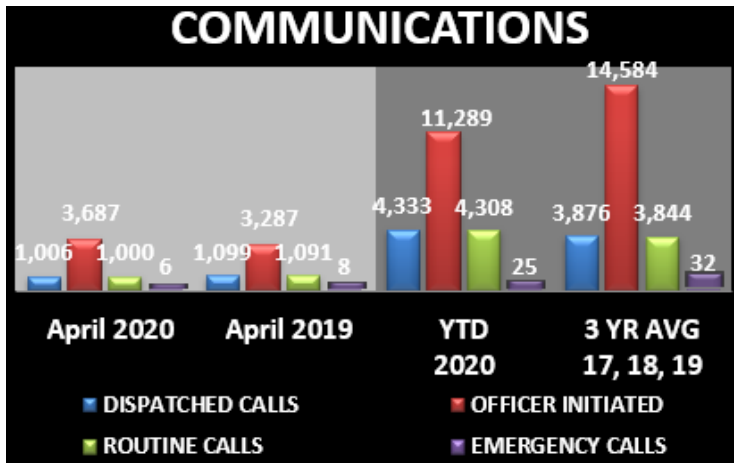
### COMMUNICATIONS

Officer Initiated Calls increased **12%**

In April, there were **1,000** routine calls, **1,006** dispatched calls, and **6** emergency calls. Officer Initiated Activity was at **3,687**. The average response time for priority one calls was **3:52**.

In April, there were **87** alarms. Officers assisted Phoenix Fire **25** times in April.

Alarms decreased **54%**



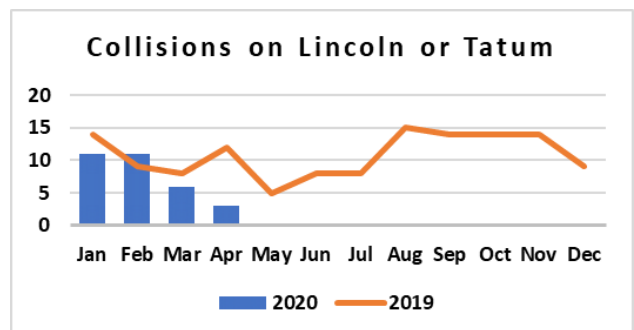
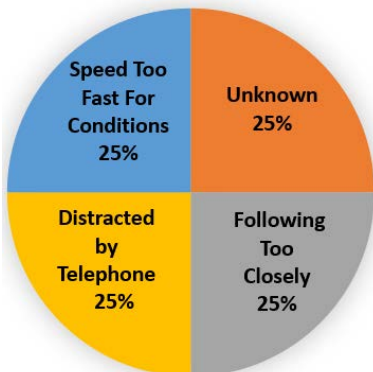
### TRAFFIC

Non-Injury collisions decreased **73%**
