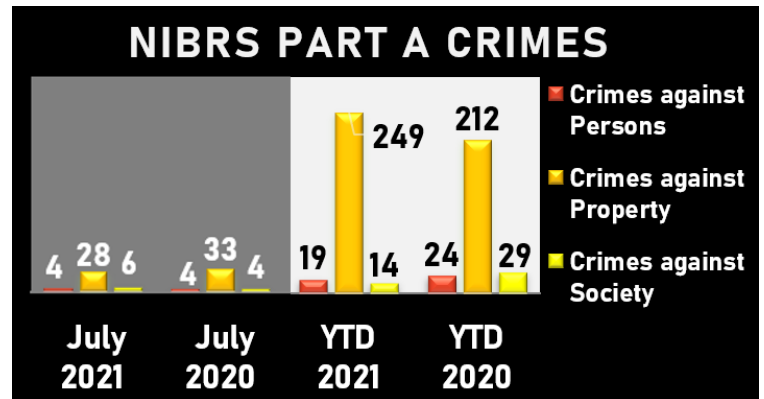
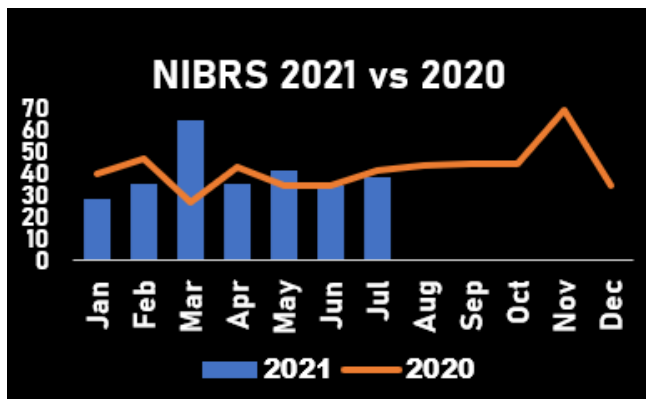

January 1, 2021, the FBI has retired the UCR Summary Reporting System (SRS) and transitioned to National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The FBI's transition to a NIBRS only data collection will improve the nations crime data through rich details and greater specificity of offenses. Due to this change Paradise Valley Police will compare one-year data versus three-year data.

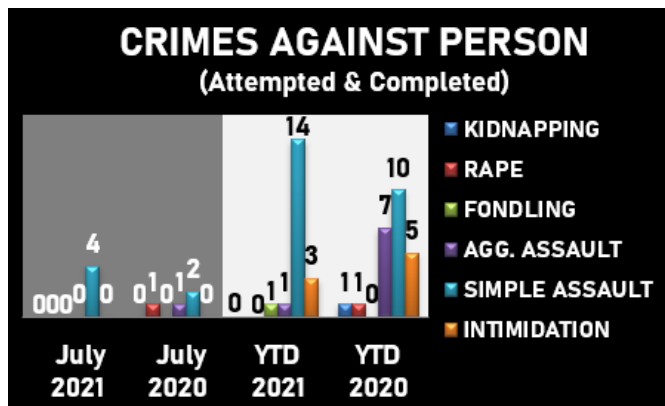
- NIBRS include: Crimes against Persons, Property & Society crimes.
 - NIBRS collects data from 52 offenses, plus 10 additional offenses for which only arrests are reported.
- In July, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported 38 crimes to the FBI.
 - There were 4 crime against persons, 28 property crimes and 6 crime against society.



CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons, e.g., murder, rape, and assault, are those whose victims are always individuals.

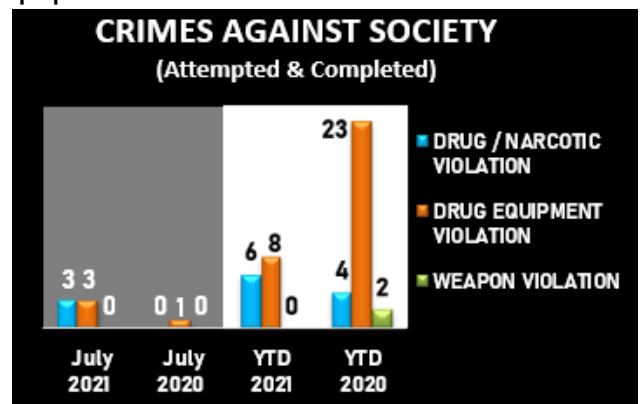
In July, persons crimes consisted of 4 simple assaults cases.



CRIMES AGAINST SOCIETY

Crimes Against Society, e.g., gambling, prostitution, and drug violations; they are typically crimes in which property is not the object.

In July, society crimes consisted of 3 drug narcotic violations and 3 drug equipment violations.

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

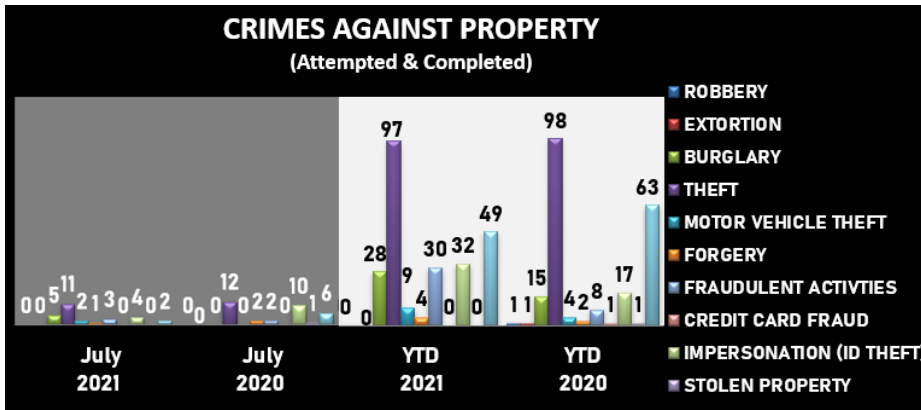
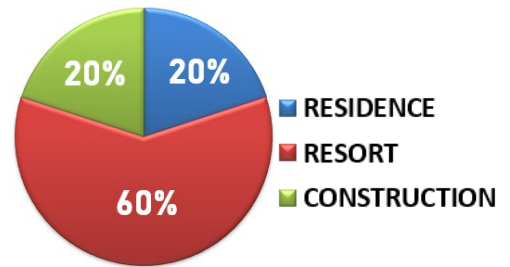
Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.

Damage to Property decreased

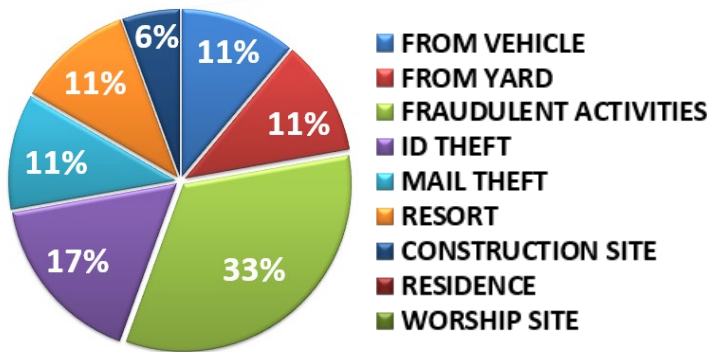

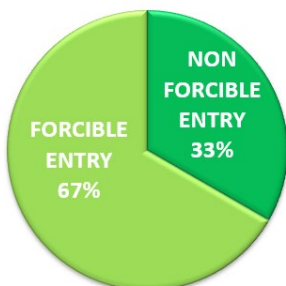

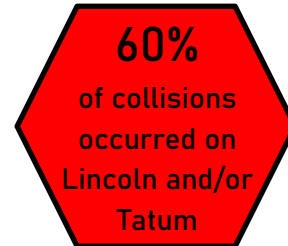
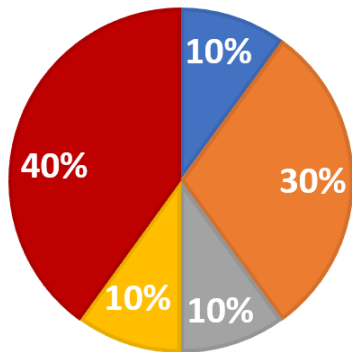
In July, there were **128** alarms. Officers assisted Phoenix Fire **13** times in July.



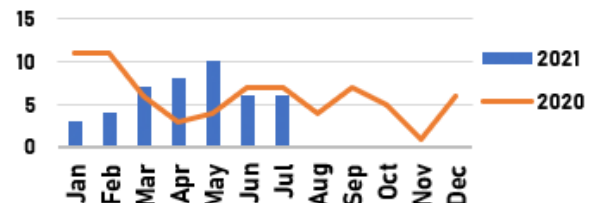
TRAFFIC
