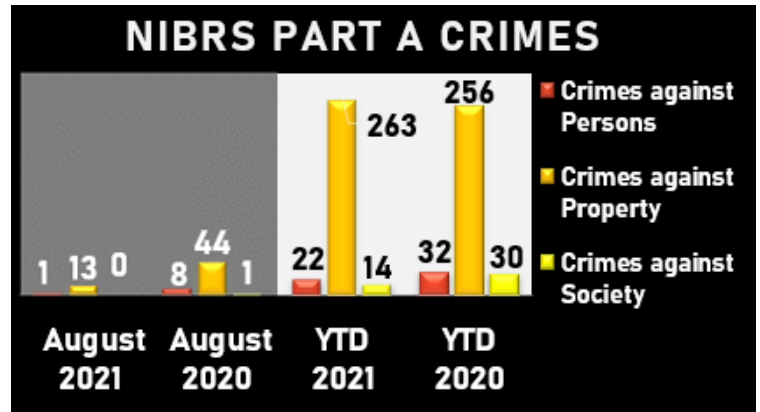
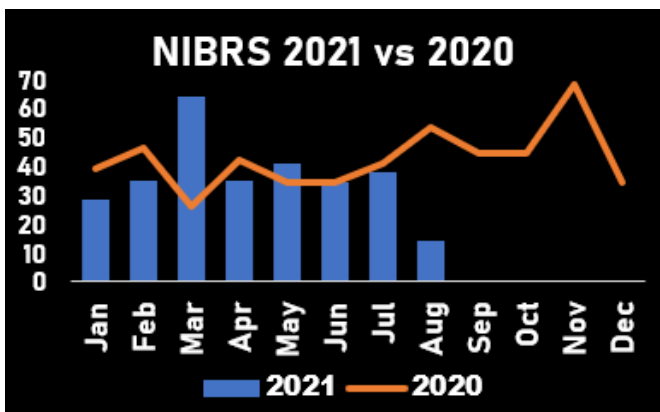

January 1, 2021, the FBI has retired the UCR Summary Reporting System (SRS) and transitioned to National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The FBI's transition to a NIBRS only data collection will improve the nations crime data through rich details and greater specificity of offenses. Due to this change Paradise Valley Police will compare one-year data versus three-year data.

- NIBRS include: Crimes against Persons, Property & Society crimes.
  - NIBRS collects data from 52 offenses, plus 10 additional offenses for which only arrests are reported.
- In August, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported 14 crimes to the FBI.
  - There were 1 crime against persons, 13 property crimes and 0 crime against society.



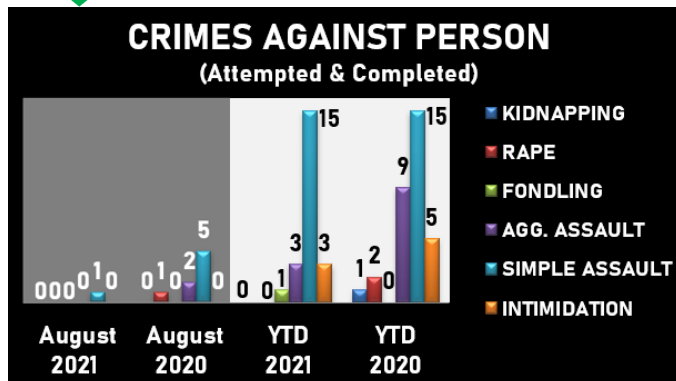
## CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons, e.g., murder, rape, and assault, are those whose victims are always individuals.

Simple Assaults decreased

80%

In August, persons crimes consisted of 1 simple assault case.



## CRIMES AGAINST SOCIETY

Crimes Against Society, e.g., gambling, prostitution, and drug violations; they are typically crimes in which property is not the object.

There were 0 crimes against society in August.

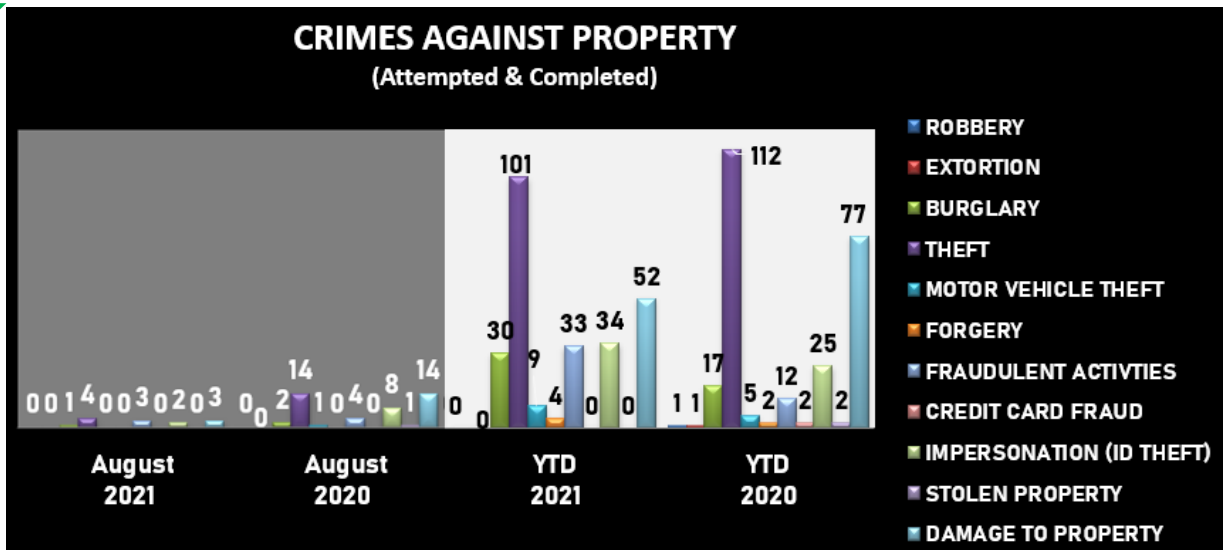
## CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.

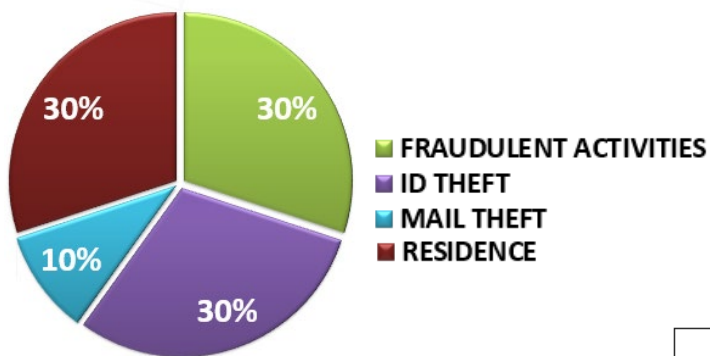
Damage to Property decreased

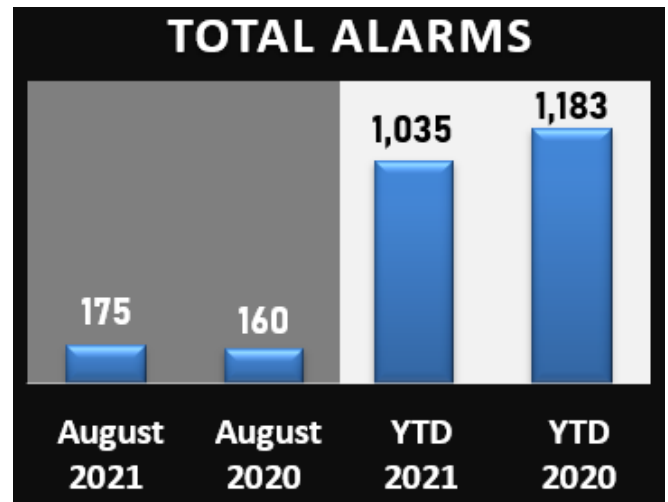
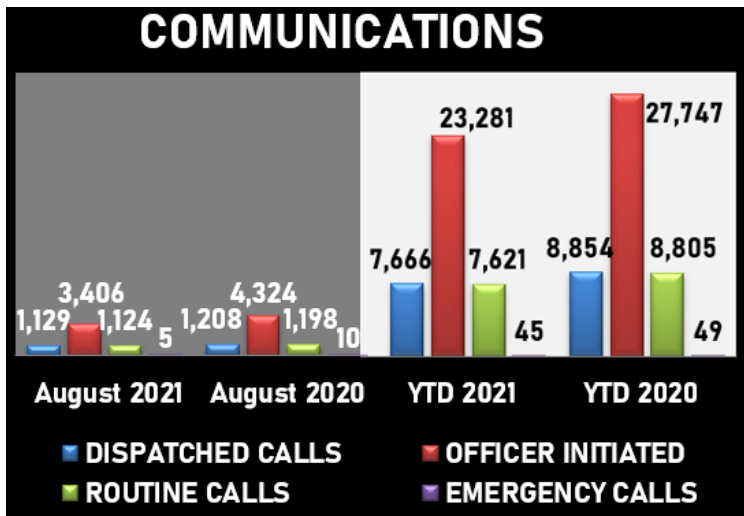

In August, there were 175 alarms. Officers assisted Phoenix Fire 25 times in August.

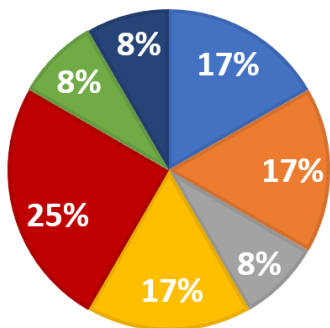

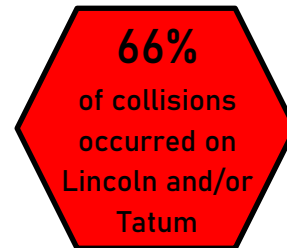
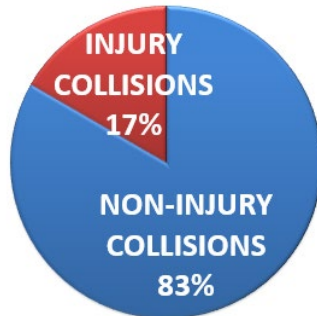


In August, there were 10 non-injury collisions and 2 injury collisions.

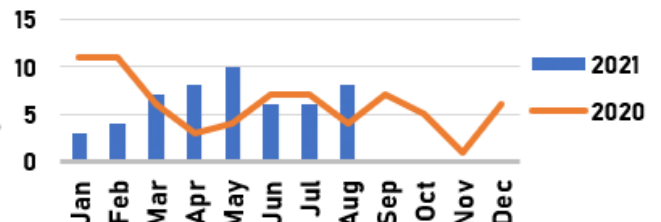
Officers wrote 340 traffic citations, parking violations and traffics warnings in August.
