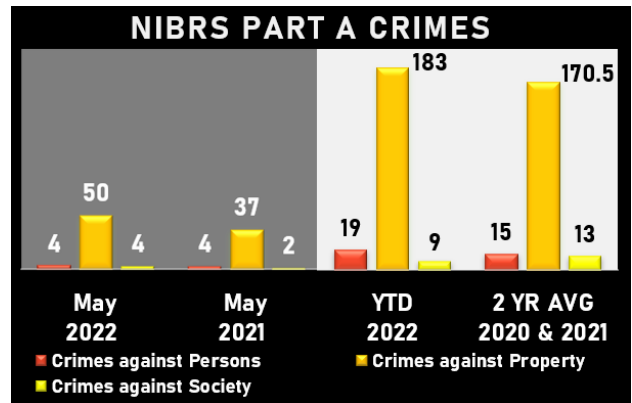
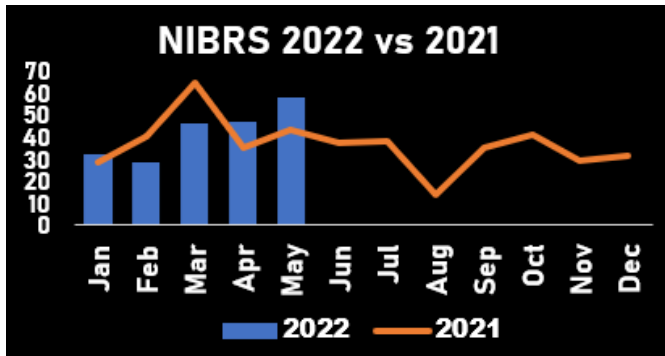

January 1, 2021, the FBI has retired the UCR Summary Reporting System (SRS) and transitioned to National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The FBI's transition to a NIBRS only data collection will improve the nations crime data through rich details and greater specificity of offenses. Due to this change Paradise Valley Police will compare one-year data versus three-year data.

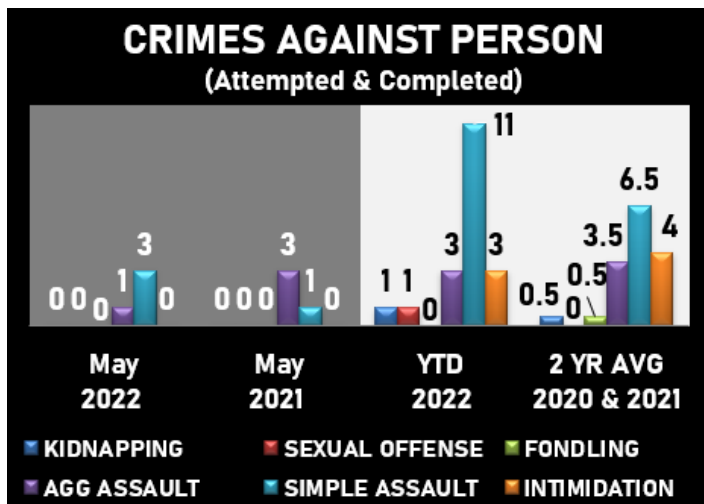
- NIBRS include Crimes against Persons, Property & Society crimes.
 - NIBRS collects data from 52 offenses, plus 10 additional offenses for which only arrests are reported.
- In May, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported 58 crimes to the FBI.
 - There were 4 crimes against person, 50 property crimes and 4 crimes against society.



CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons, e.g., murder, rape, and assault, are those whose victims are always individuals.

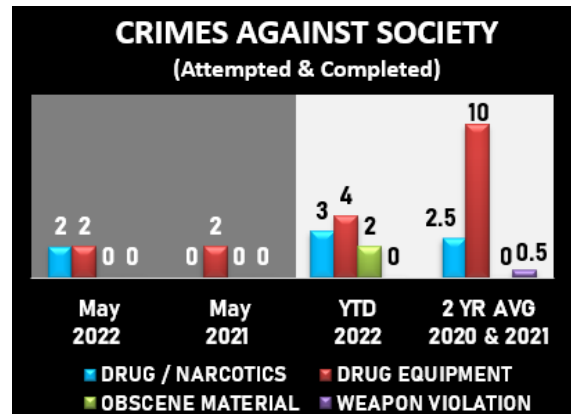
In May, persons crimes consisted of 3 simple assaults and 1 aggravated assault cases.



CRIMES AGAINST SOCIETY

Crimes Against Society, e.g., gambling, prostitution, and drug violations; they are typically crimes in which property is not the object.

In May, society crimes consisted of 2 drug equipment violations and 2 drug/narcotic violations.

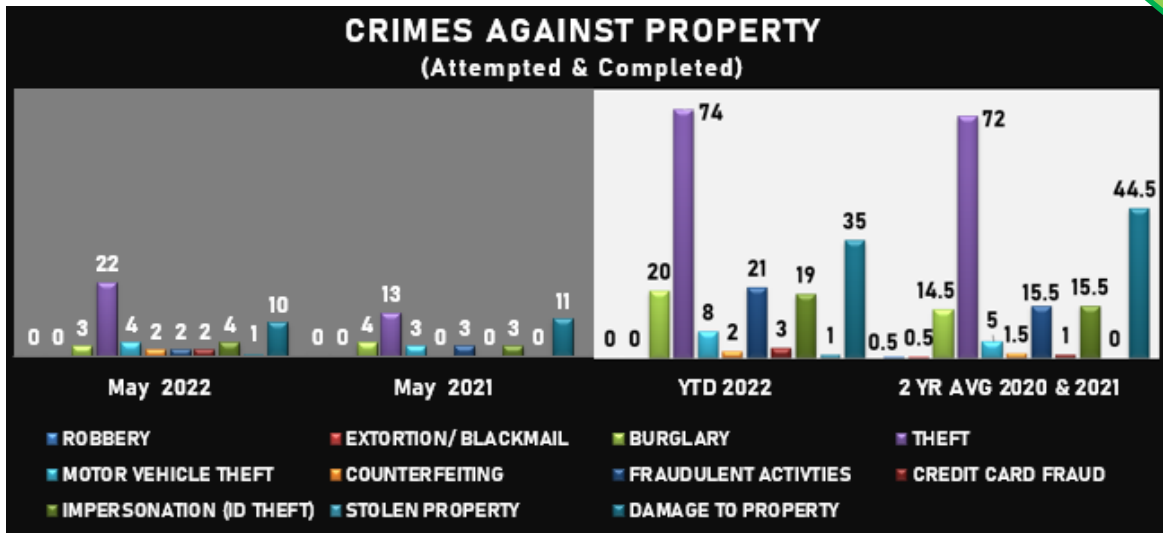


CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.

In May, property crimes consisted of 3 burglaries, 22 thefts, 4 motor vehicle thefts, 6 fraudulent activities, 4 impersonation (ID theft), 1 stolen property and 10 property damage cases.

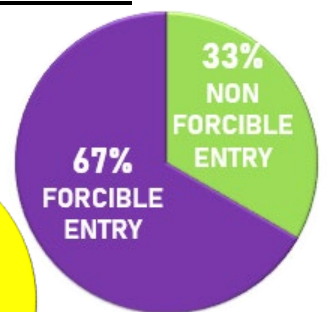
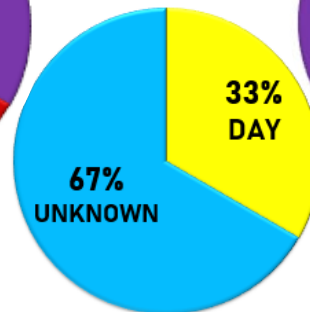
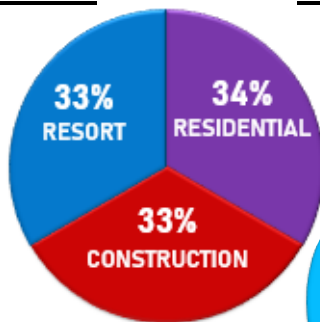


THEFT FROM VEHICLE ANALYSIS

BURGLARY ANALYSIS

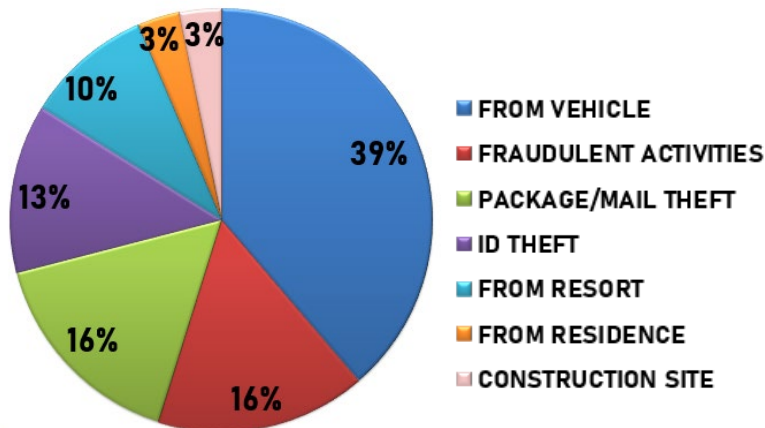

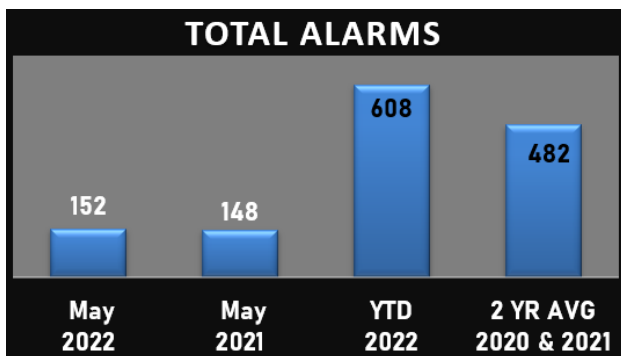
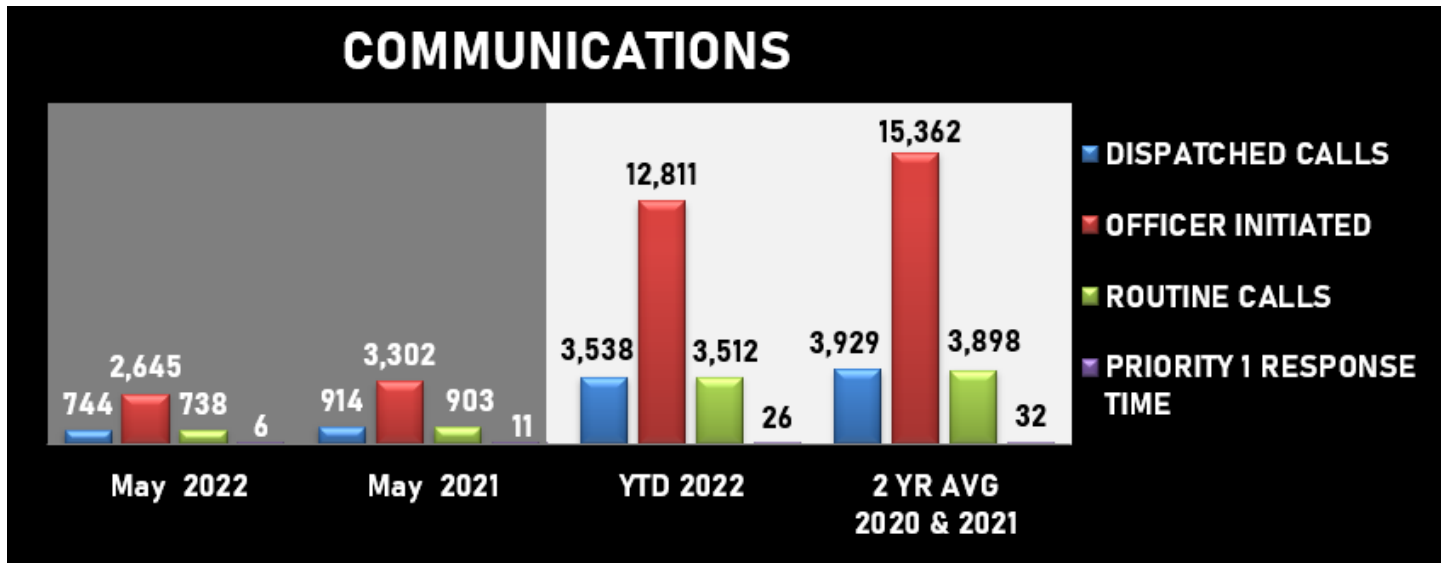

COMMUNICATIONS

In May, there were 744 dispatched calls, 738 routine calls, and 6 priority calls. Officer initiated activity was at 2,645. The average response time for priority one calls was 3:29.

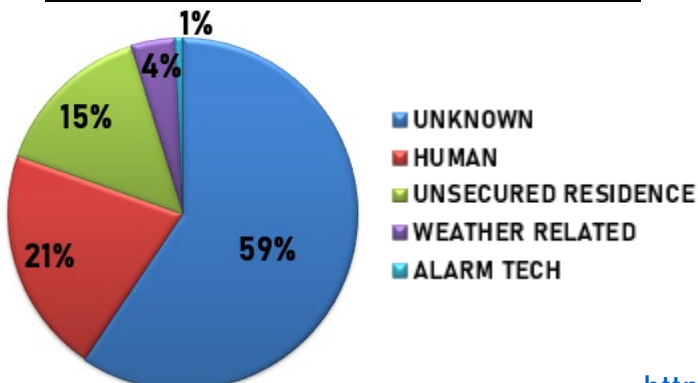


ALARMS- 2021

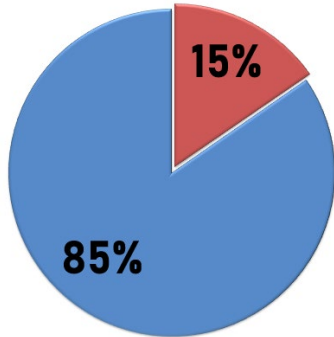

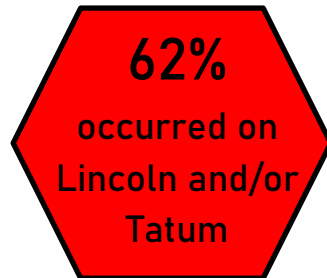

In May, there were **2** injury collisions and **11** non-injury collisions.

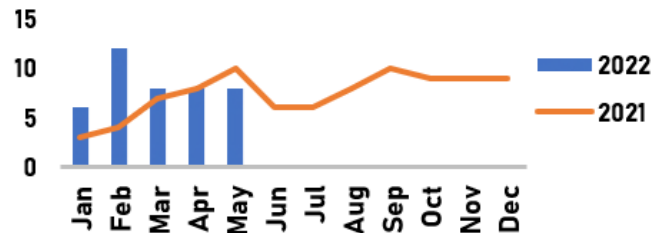


■ NON-INJURY COLLISIONS

COLLISIONS ON LINCOLN OR TATUM

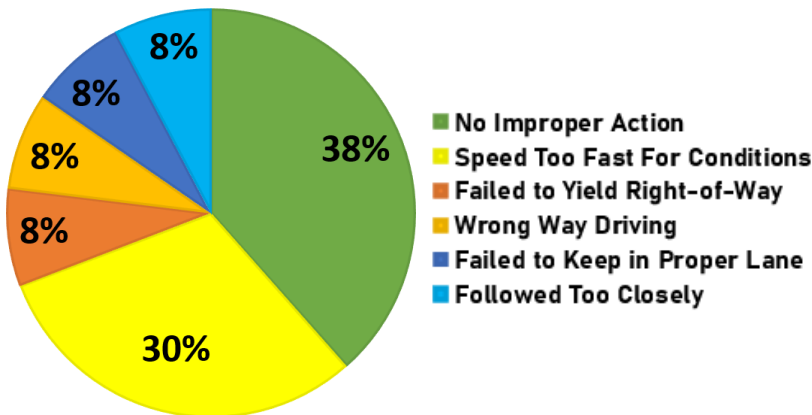


TOP 5 CITATION CHARGES
