

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2022-20

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY,
MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING
AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY
ELECTION FOR MAYOR, TOWN COUNCIL, AND
PROPOSITION 467 HELD ON AUGUST 2, 2022**

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, held a Primary Election on the 2ND day of August, 2022 for the non-partisan at-large election of the Mayor, three Council Members, and Proposition 467 (the 2022 General Plan); and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-204, the Town's election was consolidated with the Maricopa County Primary Election ballot; and,

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to, and have been canvassed by, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley pursuant to A.R.S. §16-642 and 16-646.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of valid ballots cast at said primary election, as shown by the poll lists, was 5,254;

SECTION 2. That the total number of rejected ballots equaled 58 (8 no signatures, 24 returned late, 26 bad signatures);

SECTION 3. That the total number of provisional ballots equaled 14. Six ballots were accepted. Eight ballots were rejected (2 not registered to vote, 4 not eligible to vote in this election, and 2 early ballots were sent, returned, and counted.)

SECTION 4. That the total number of votes cast for each candidate for the Office of Mayor were as follows:




