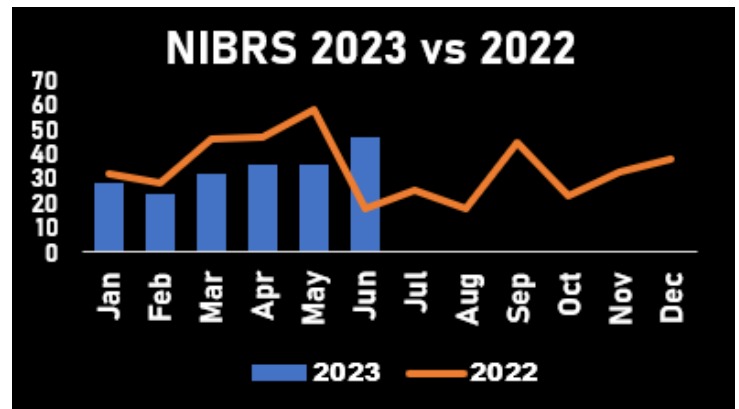
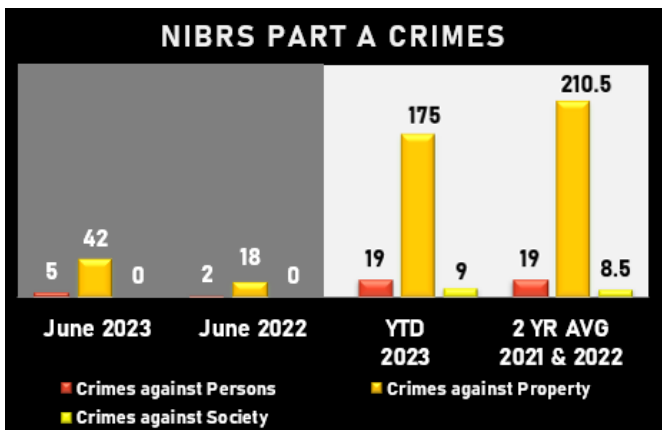

January 1, 2021, the FBI has retired the UCR Summary Reporting System (SRS) and transitioned to National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The FBI's transition to a NIBRS only data collection will improve the nations crime data through rich details and greater specificity of offenses.

- NIBRS include Crimes against Persons, Property & Society crimes.
 - NIBRS collects data from 52 offenses, plus 10 additional offenses for which only arrests are reported.
- In June, the Paradise Valley Police Department reported **47** crimes to the FBI.
 - There were **5** crimes against persons, **42** property crimes and **0** crimes against society.



CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons, e.g., murder, rape, and assault, are those whose victims are always individuals.

In June, persons crimes consisted of **4** simple assaults and **1** intimidation case.



CRIMES AGAINST SOCIETY

Crimes Against Society, e.g., gambling, prostitution, and drug violations; they are typically crimes in which property is not the object.

There were **0** crimes against society in June.

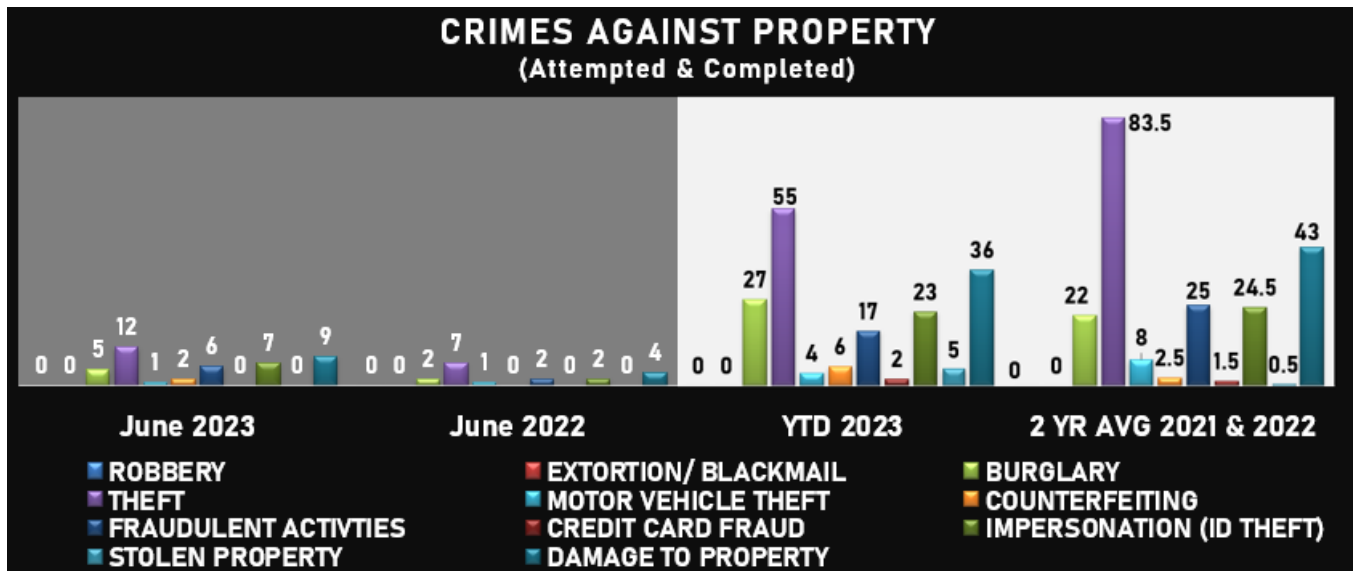

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY

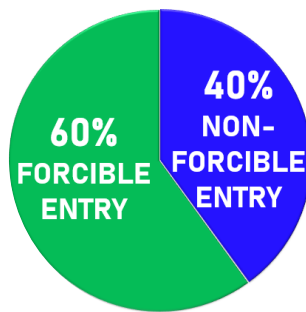
Crimes Against Property, e.g., robbery, bribery, and burglary, is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit.

In June, property crimes consisted of 5 burglaries, 12 thefts, 1 motor vehicle theft, 2 counterfeit, 6 fraudulent activities, 7 impersonations (ID theft), and 9 property damage cases.

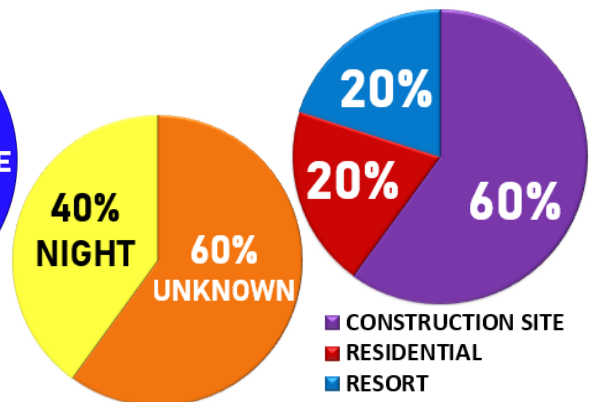


THEFT FROM VEHICLE ANALYSIS

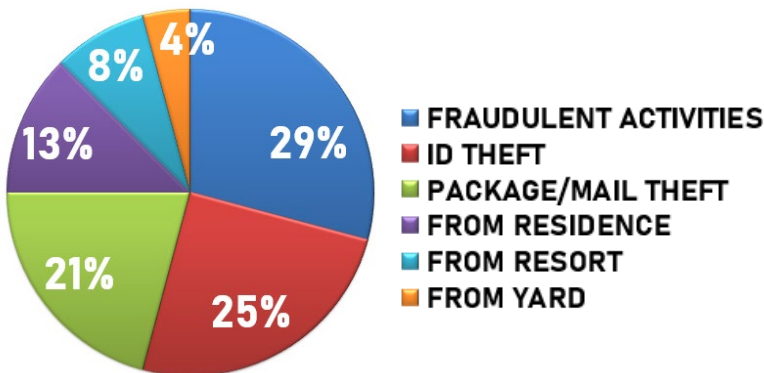

TOP 5 CITATION CHARGES

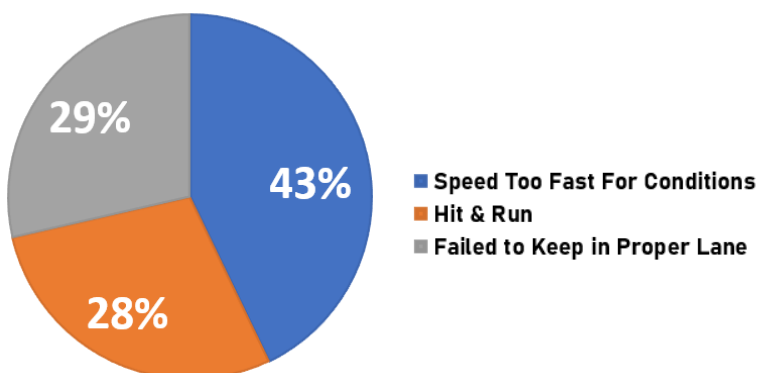
- 28-701A- Speeding/ Failure to Control Vehicle to Avoid a Collision

Officers wrote **146** traffic citations, parking violations and traffic warnings.

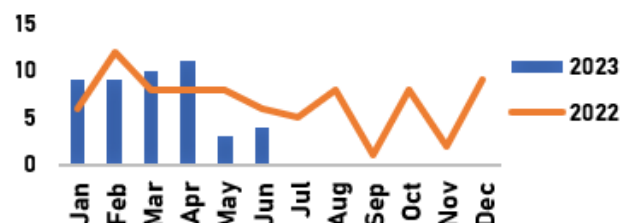


BEHAVIORS CAUSING COLLISIONS
