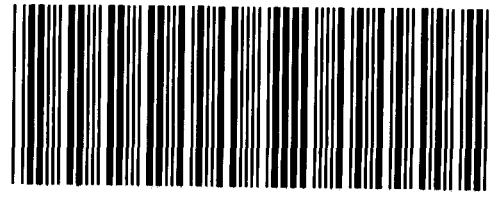

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1008

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY,
MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING
AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL
ELECTION HELD FOR PROPOSITION 414 ON
NOVEMBER 7, 2000.**

19 WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, held a
20 Special Election on the 7th day of November, 2000 for Proposition 414 seeking
21 voter approval to permanently adjust the expenditure base of the Town of Paradise
22 Valley as determined by the Ariona State Economic Estimates Commission; and

23 WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to, and have been
24 canvassed by, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of
26 the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

27 SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said special election, as
28 shown by the poll lists was 7,688, a voter turnout equal to 85.6%.

29 SECTION 2. That the total number of votes cast by precinct for (YES) and
30 against (NO) were as follows:



5 cast and that Proposition 414 is hereby approved.


1 SECTION 5. That all orders or resolutions in conflict be and the same are, to the

3 effect immediately upon its adoption.

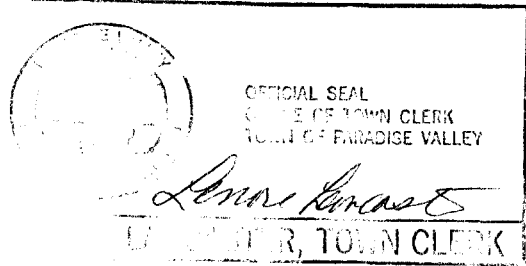


