**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND  
COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE  
VALLEY, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS  
OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD FOR  
TOWN COUNCIL ON MARCH 12, 2002**

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, held a  
Primary Election on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2002 for the non-partisan at-large  
election of three Council Members; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution Number 1020 the election was  
conducted by "all-mail ballot"; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to, and have been  
canvassed by, the Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of  
the Town of Paradise Valley, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said primary election,  
as shown by the poll lists was 2,624.

SECTION 2. That a total of 8 ballots were rejected.

SECTION 3. That the total votes cast for each candidate for Town Council



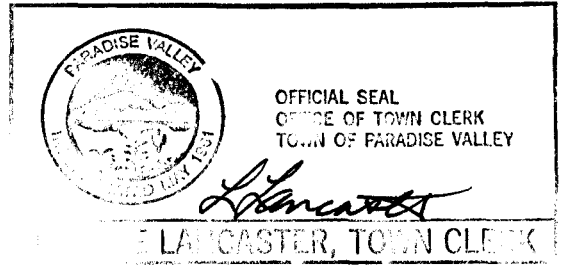
