Burglary - Residential Case# 2018-51823

On December 7, 2018 at approximately 1313 hours, the Paradise Valley Police Department responded to the report of a residential burglary in the 5200 block of East Paradise Canyon Rd. Entry was found to have been made through windows at the back of house that were broken out by rocks. A designer purse was the only item taken. Installed alarm system was active.

The Paradise Valley Police Department's Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) will be following up on this crime. Using alarms usually reduces the amount of time burglars are inside your house and the amount of property they have time to steal. It also causes them to rush which often leads to mistakes and additional evidence being left enhancing the chance of catching the suspect and recovering any stolen property. Marking property or logging serial numbers also greatly increases the chance of recovery.
