Case Update – Arrest made

On September 18, 2019, the Paradise Valley Police Department received a report of a theft which had occurred in the 6100 block of N 38<sup>th</sup> St. The Paradise Valley Police Department's Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) followed up on the investigation which led to the recovery of several items which had been identified by the victim as being stolen. On September 19, 2019, detectives assigned to the CIU arrested Gary J. Galvan relating to this theft report. At the time of the theft, Galvan was employed as a caretaker for the victim's family. Galvan was later booked into the Maricopa County 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. Jail pending criminal charges for Felony Theft and Trafficking in Stolen Property.
