### Arrest Made in Theft Case 2020-5681



**Eve Wilson, 48 of Mesa, AZ**

The Paradise Valley Police Department's Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) was conducting an ongoing investigation into a reported theft. It was reported that the widower of the victim noted that his late wife's wallet and wedding ring was missing. The complainant also learned that his late wife's credit card had been used in Mesa shortly after her death.

Detective Jensen obtained video of the transactions as well as pawn store history that identified Eve Wilson as the person who conducted the fraudulent credit card charges and pawned the wedding ring. Eve Wilson was also the caretaker of the complainant's late wife.

On April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 Wilson was taken into custody without incident and made a full admission concerning the theft of the property and fraudulent use of the credit cards. She was then processed on several felony charges are being referred to the Maricopa County Attorney's Office.
