On July 25, 2020, The Paradise Valley Police Department received a report of a Domestic Violence incident, which had just occurred in the 4800 block of East Horseshoe Road. During the incident, the victim reported that she was threatened with a knife, physically assaulted, strangled, and sexually assaulted. Officers obtained crucial evidence to establish probable cause for the arrest of David Lewis Conley and responded to the residence. During the incident, Conley made homicidal and suicidal statements by use of a knife and a firearm. Due to the threat assessment on Conley, officers and the Paradise Valley Police Department Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) requested the Phoenix Police Department Special Assignment Unit (SAU) to assist with the arrest. At approximately 7:19 am, Paradise Valley Police and Phoenix Police took Conley into custody without incident and a search warrant was executed on the residence. Conley was later booked into the Maricopa County 4th Avenue Jail for Sexual Assault, Aggravated Assault, and Aggravated Domestic Violence.
